The development of a Park Master Plan began as a vision statement in the city's comprehensive plan. [The City of Tenino Planning Commission](#), along with citizens and city staff, developed the comprehensive plan. The plan contains goals and policies that guide the City of Tenino in its actions and decisions.

The current plan was drafted by the City of Tenino Park Commission and sent to the Tenino City Council in January 2016 and presented for public hearings in February 2016. This plan is intended to ensure that the city's park system and its management meet our future development needs.
