The City of Tenino and Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) are seeking comments to the City's Shoreline Master Program (SMP) periodic review and proposed SMP

amendments. The joint local/state public comment period will run 30 days from February 5, 2021, 5:00pm. These amendments were developed by the City to comply with WAC 173-26-090, which requires all local governments to review their SMP's on an eight-year schedule set in the state law and revise if necessary. The review ensures the SMP keeps up with changes in state laws, changes in other local jurisdictions' plans and regulations, and other changed circumstances. The City has elected to use the optional joint review process to combine the local and Ecology comment periods, as allowed under WAC 173-26-104.
